Tom Hobson (aka Teacher Tom) is a preschool teacher, blogger, speaker, artist and the author of Teacher Tom's First Book - a collection of short essays about teaching and learning from preschoolers, by turns hilarious, thought-provoking, and moving.

Hobson is known as one of the world's leading practitioners of 'democratic play-based' education. *'Children are born to learn, and self-directed play is how it is meant to happen,'* says Hobson. *'A play-based education is one in which children educate themselves by asking and answering their own questions. *It is a privilege to have Teacher Tom join us in New Zealand to speak on Play Based Learning and the ways we as adults can support children's thinking and learning.*

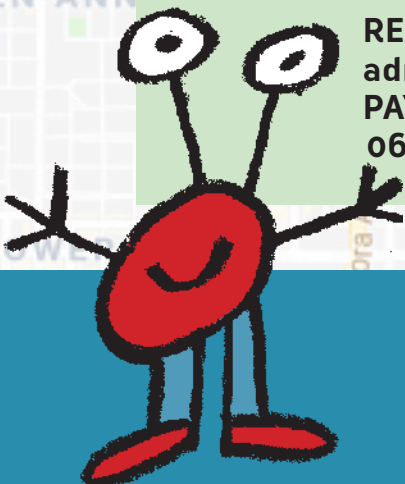
